Nominations	Deadlines for nominations and applications: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • 15th April for Autumn semester. • 15th October for Spring semester.
Applications	Kristiania Professional College is using an online nomination and application system for incoming exchange students. Before the student can apply the home institution must officially nominate the student using the Nomination Portal. Nominated students are then invited to register an application in the Application Portal. Instructions on how to use the portals may be found on our website.
Shorter exchanges	Courses are open for shorter exchanges on a case by case basis.
Courses offered in English	Kristiania Professional College offers a wide variety of vocational programmes, both one-year certificates and two-year diplomas. Courses taught in English are being developed on demand.
Course structure and study	All academic programmes have semesters split into four main subject areas, typically with the following focus areas: Concept, Process and

plans	Tools, Problem Solving and Value Creation, Complex Vocational Challenges, and finally Professionalisation.
Structure of study programmes	Certificates: 1 year, 60 ECTS. Each course worth 7,5 ECTS. Diploma: 2 years, 120 ECTS. Each course worth 7,5 ECTS. Note: Level 5 in the EQF – European Qualifications Framework.
Grading system	The Norwegian grading system consists of two grading scales: one scale with the grades pass or fail and one graded scale from A to E for pass and F for fail. The graded scale has the following qualitative descriptions: A – Excellent; B – Very good; C – Good; D – Satisfactory; E – Sufficient; F – Fail. The scale is used absolutely (criterion referenced assessment).
Transcript of record	The student can order a transcript of record in “Studentweb” for a limited time after the exchange (approx. 6 mths). A digital transcript (pdf) will be generated automatically to the document folder in your profile.

Welcome session	Arranged by the Dept. of Research Administration and Internationalisation at the beginning of the each semester.
Buddy system	Each exchange student will be allocated a buddy.
Evaluations	Incoming students will be called in for an evaluation session before the end of the semester by the Dept. of Research Administration and Internationalisation.
Accommodation	Apply for affordable student housing through ‘The Student Welfare Organisation of Oslo and Akershus’ (SiO) as soon as possible after acceptance: https://www.sio.no/en/housing
Health and travel insurance	Students are responsible for appropriate medical insurance and a private insurance/travel insurance to cover dental care or cover injuries, or damage caused to other people's belongings or property. European students must bring their European health insurance card.
